Sorry to hear that Angela's husband George has been ill in hospital; we wish him a speedy recovery.

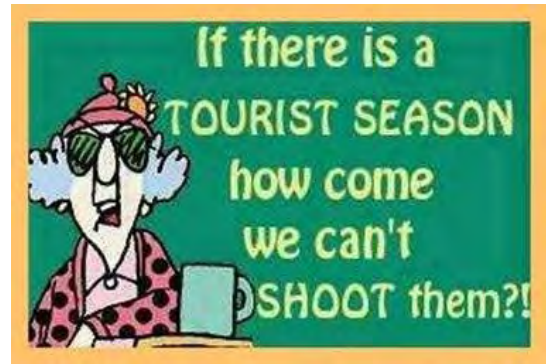
Anna is holidaying in New Zealand and having a great time.

Great to see many of the earlier class staying on to dance with Stephen's class - well done.

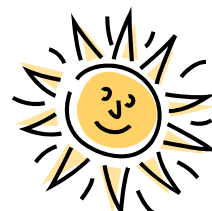
Ben Anderson, formerly from Cairns, is now living in Brisbane, (lucky for us) and it means we have another **male** clogger!! A big welcome, Ben.

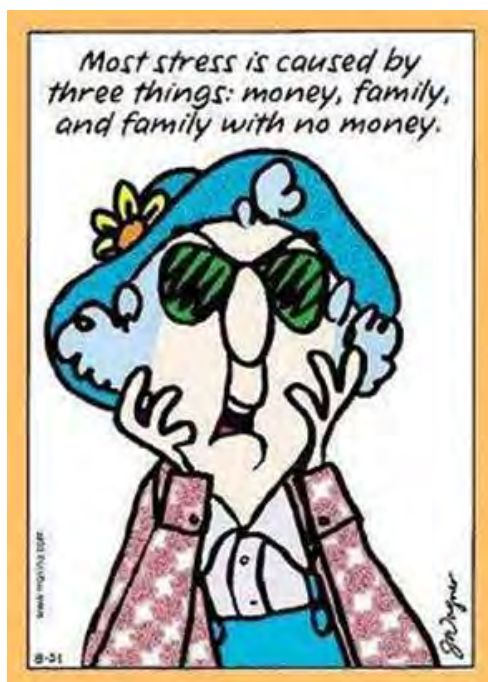

Familiar and new faces are back in force as 2012 looks like a great year of Clogging at our old, but faithful Red Cross Hall.

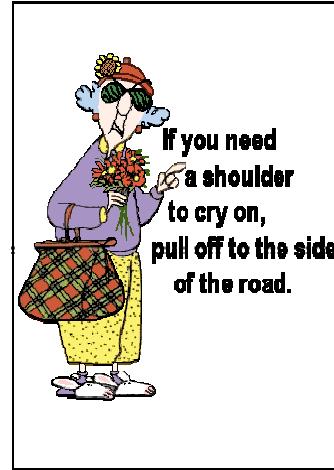

MAXINES



John Wagner, Hallmark artist since 1970, says Maxine was inspired by his mother, his maiden aunts and his grandmother, the woman who bought him art lessons when 'fill in the pumpkins' was about the extent of his art classes at St. John's Catholic School in Leonia N.J.

John remembers doodling as a preschooler and says both his grandmother and his mother encouraged his artistic interests. He eventually attended the Vesper George School of Art in Boston and landed at Hallmark as part of a new artists group. But it was the birth of the humorous *Shoebox Greetings* (a tiny little division of Hallmark) in 1986 that added a new dimension to John's professional life. The *Shoebox* way of seeing the world unleashed his talents and he created *Maxine*.

'Cartoonists are sensitive to the insanities of the world; we just try to humanize them,' John says. 'If Maxine can get a laugh out of someone who feels lonely or someone who is getting older and hates the thought of another birthday, or if she can make someone chuckle about stressful interpersonal relationships, then I'm happy. Putting a smile on someone's face is what it's all about.' Many people say they are just like her.

Why the name 'Maxine'? 'People at *Shoebox* started referring to the character as 'John Wagner's old lady,' and I knew that would get me into trouble with my wife,' John says. The *Shoebox* team had a contest among themselves to name the character and three of the approximately 30 entries suggested 'Maxine'. John says the name is perfect.

John, who says he's humbled by such acceptance of *Maxine*, admits he's proud of her.

Now you know the story of how *Maxine* came to be.

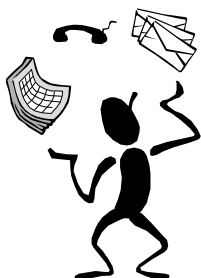

○ Venue

St Clair Recreation Centre, 109 Woodville Road, Woodville, in the district of Charles Sturt Council Situated approximately 10 kilometres north west of the Adelaide CBD and run by Casa Leisure, is a large venue with halls all under one roof, ample car parking space, accessible by public transport with a range of accommodation nearby.

All levels of dancing will be catered for We'll have Social Dancing on Friday and Saturday nights, and three workshop halls offering a variety of instructors and levels throughout Saturday and on Sunday morning. A *Trail In Dance* on Thursday 20 September at 7.30pm will be held at a venue to be announced.

○ Banner Parade

Please register your club for the Banner Parade The parade is part of the opening event, and Club Leaders need to report in the main hall with their banner at 6.30pm sharp on Friday night. Please register your club for the banner parade. Please also supply a paragraph about your club, and include the name of your club leaders, where you're from and when your club was founded.

○ Your Safety

Your Personal Safety By registering for this event, you are accepting responsibility for your personal safety while participating in all activities.

The ACA holds public liability insurance.

Tap check You are required to present your shoes for tap checking at the time you pick up your registration pack. To prevent delays, please pre-tape your shoes and ensure you re-tape your shoes daily before entering, thank you.

○ Use of Video Cameras

The use of video cameras are only permitted at the back of the hall and are not to interfere with the official recording of the event or be distracting to dancers. The committee reserves the right to ban their use if necessary.



Simone Nichols Pace

Simone is from South Carolina, USA and began clogging at age 2 and teaching from 12. She was three times World Champion before the age of 20 and is best known for several award-winning dance teams in the US including the Silver Bullets and Carolina Gold, and for her talents in choreography and as an instructor. She has won many coveted awards and was named in America's Clogging Hall of Fame for 'All American Team' and 'All American Gold Team'. She comes from a background education of computer programming, sales and cosmetology. Her great sense of humour and sparkling personality makes her a very popular instructor. Simone teaches from Beginner through Advanced, traditional clogging as well as contemporary.
