

# Choreography Competition Entry Rules for 2020

## **The Entrant:**

1. Must be living in Australia and be a financial ACA member.
2. Will be able to choose from two competition levels: **Easy Intermediate or Intermediate.**
3. Will be eligible to enter if they have not had any of their originally choreographed clogging routines taught at an ACA National Clogging Convention or used as a State Showcase.
4. Must not submit a routine that has been workshopped or demonstrated outside their own club or posted online.
5. May submit only **one** of their original choreographed routines to be judged.
6. Must submit by **3<sup>rd</sup> June 2020**, an **UNSTAMPED** cue sheet for one of two competition streams, either the Easy Intermediate level category or the Intermediate level category in Word Format to Chris Anderson email: [choreocomp@cloggingaustralia.com](mailto:choreocomp@cloggingaustralia.com)
7. Will be anonymous to online voters, so their name or any identifying material on the cue sheet will be removed prior to publishing on the ACA Website.
8. Is **not** required to send in a video of their routine. Each entry will be demonstrated by one person for each category and the video uploaded to YouTube as unlisted and untitled. The video may **not** be reposted.

## **Winner's Prize**

The choreographer of the winning entry in each category will receive **one free weekend Registration for an ACA National Clogging Convention**

The winning dance from each category will be taught at the 24<sup>th</sup> ACA National Clogging Convention, Adelaide, SA from 8 -11 October, 2020.
